## Revelation 22:6-21 - Adult Sunday School 4-24-2022

**Vs. 6** – Everything Jesus says is trustworthy because His character is such.

- The word "soon" should not be interpreted to mean everything in Revelation would happen immediately. "Soon" can mean "quickly, speedily."
- When things begin in Revelation, they will move along.

<u>Vs. 7</u> – Jesus can return at any time. The word "soon" in <u>vs. 7</u> is closely connected in "soon in <u>vs. 6</u>, but here it means "quickly," "without delay." His return is "imminent."

- The word "keeps" means "observe." We are to pay attention to all Christ has told us in Revelation.

<u>Vss. 8-9</u> – John is told, and it is a good reminder, God alone should get our worship.

Vss. 10-12 – Some prophecies were sealed up as in Dan. 8:26; 12:4-10.

- God will judge the world and reward the righteous.

**Vs. 13** – Christ is eternal God.

**Vss. 14-15** – We are forgiven of ourselves.

- We dwell with God. The lost do not.

Vs. 16 - Fulfilled prophecy. Jesus is the "Brightest Star."

**Vs. 17** – Jesus promises to return and we see the Sprit and church looking forward to His return.

<u>Vss. 18-19</u> – We are to hear and obey the book of Revelation. This warning seems stronger than ones found in <u>Deut. 4:2</u>; <u>Deut. 12:32</u>; **Pro. 30:5-6**; <u>Jer. 26:2</u>.

- "Takes away" in vs. 19 means "to remove."

<u>Vss. 20-21</u> – To Jesus, His return will be quick. He is not limited by time.

- In <u>2 Peter 3:11-18</u>, how we are to live in light of Christ's return is lined out for us.
