

Revelation 22:6-21 - Adult Sunday School

Vs. 6 – Everything Jesus says is trustworthy because His character is such.

- The word “soon” should not be interpreted to mean everything in Revelation would happen immediately. “Soon” can mean “quickly, speedily.”
- When things begin in Revelation, they will move along.

Vs. 7 – Jesus can return at any time. The word “soon” in **vs. 7** is closely connected in “soon in **vs. 6**, but here it means “quickly,” “without delay.” His return is “imminent.”

- The word “keeps” means “observe.” We are to pay attention to all Christ has told us in Revelation.

Vss. 8-9 – John is told, and it is a good reminder, God alone should get our worship.

Vss. 10-12 – Some prophecies were sealed up as in **Dan. 8:26; 12:4-10**.

- God will judge the world and reward the righteous.

Vs. 13 – Christ is eternal God.

Vss. 14-15 – We are forgiven of ourselves.

- We dwell with God. The lost do not.

Vs. 16 – Fulfilled prophecy. Jesus is the “Brightest Star.”

Vs. 17 – Jesus promises to return and we see the Spirit and church looking forward to His return.

Vss. 18-19 – We are to hear and obey the book of Revelation. This warning seems stronger than ones found in **Deut. 4:2; Deut. 12:32; Pro. 30:5-6; Jer. 26:2**.

- “Takes away” in **vs. 19** means “to remove.”

Vss. 20-21 – To Jesus, His return will be quick. He is not limited by time.

- In **2 Peter 3:11-18**, how we are to live in light of Christ’s return is lined out for us.
